Open: The meeting was called to order by President Tom Wilson and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

F.C. Comprehensive Plan: tabled for 1 or 2 weeks.

Becky Oglesby: Franklin County Council President addressed the Commissioners with concern over the Affordable Care Act. She stated the Auditor's office is burdened with a lot of paperwork and the Dept. Heads are responsible in tracking hours worked of Part-time employees. She stated she had made calls to Michael Kramer from Pinnacle, the County Representative with Med Ben of which he has not returned calls. We need to have assistance with the paperwork and making sure we do not have errors which in the event could cost the county a sizeable amount of money in fines. She also suggested that is a concern that maybe we need to have an Human Resource person on staff. Auditor Stephen Brack also suggested that the Dept. Heads need to step up and be responsible in tracking of hours and it is quite possible we need a new payroll program. It was suggested that Mike Kramer attend a Commissioners meeting for a question and answer session.

Ted Cooley – Franklin County Highway Engineer – A motion was made by Tom Wilson to sign the agreement for rehabilitation of Bridge 56 and 144 and was 2<sup>nd</sup> y Eric Roberts. Motion carried. Information was given on the Bridge 121 Deck Replacement Project. There will be a bid meeting on July 15, 2015 regarding Bridge 168. Bridge 12 – Commissioner Roberts asked why there is only one option on this project and asked if there are other bridges like this? In addition he also asked if the Bridge Inspection Book is accurate.

Minutes: a motion was made by Tom Linkel to approve the minutes of July 6 and was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eric Roberts. Motion carried.

Claims: A motion to approve claims was made by Tom Linkel and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eric Roberts. Motion carried.

Form 144 – President Wilson stated the Auditor had given him copies of the Form 144 for review and said it had been about 10 – 12 years since the Commissioners had been given this info.

Bill Gulley: presented a request for an addition to a porch at his home. A motion was made by Tom Wilson to approve and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom Linkel. Motion carried.

Freedom from Religion: a revised application has been received for Lot 3 at the Court Lawn from Nov. 29 to Jan. 6, 2016. It has been tabled at this time.

Payroll: A motion was made by Eric Roberts to approve payroll and to have Kim Robinson make sure the numbers add up for that of Jason Robinson and was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom Linkel. The Sheriff signed off on the info requested by Mr. Roberts.

Commissioner Linkel noted he had stopped by Jansing Auto regarding the old Sheriff cars that were basically junk. He said that Jansing Auto would haul the vehicles to the scrap yard, sell the vehicles and waive the storage fee and send the County the money. Jansing would also salvage any parts that could be used again.

Adjourn: No further business a motion to adjourn was made by Tom Wilson and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eric Roberts. Motion carried.




