Commissioner Linkel will do whatever the County can to get the problem fixed.

Sara Duffy – She asked the Commissioners about the concrete bridge over Laughery Creek and where was that at. Commissioner Linkel stated that the concrete bridge was historical but now that has changed. The bridge is located near the Batesville High School.

She also asked the Commissioners about the handicap access door and whether or not it could be set to automatically unlock on night's there are meetings. Commissioners will ask the company the locks were purchased from about that. Commissioner Wendel will address this at his next ADA meeting.
