Council: Becky Oglesby, Daryl Kramer, Joe Sizemore, Dean McQueen. Absent: Hollie Maxie, Jeff Koch, and Aaron Leffingwell.

Auditor: Stephen Brack

Open: The meeting was called to order by Vice President Becky Oglesby and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: A motion was made by Joe Sizemore to approve the minutes of the previous meeting and was 2nd by Daryl Kramer.

Congrats: VP Oglesby and congratulated Council member on being re-elected: Joe Sizemore and Aaron Leffingwell and acknowledged new councilman – Keith Hall.

Additional: a motion was made by Joe Sizemore to approve additional and was 2nd by Dean McQueen. Motion carried.

Transfers: a motion to approve transfers was made by Dean McQueen and 2nd by Joe Sizemore. Motion carried. Councilman Kramer recommended that departments get additional and transfer in before spending the money.

Payroll Deputy: Daryl Kramer asked for an exception to the hiring freeze and to allow the Auditor to hire a replacement for the current Payroll Deputy as she will be retiring in March, 2015. By bringing in a new person this will give time for training that is needed to do the job. Mr. Kramer stated this position will be full-time with benefits and will be paid during the first 4 – 6 pays from the Council Contingency Fund. It was Mr. Kramer’s hope that someone who has been laid off will qualify for the position. A motion was made by Daryl Kramer to approve the Auditor to hire a trainee as payroll clerk and the position to begin on or after December 19, 2015 and was 2nd by Dean McQueen. Mr. Kramer rescinded the motion and made a new motion as: to allow the Auditor’s office to hire a trainee for payroll clerk to begin on or after Dec. 19, 2014 as a full-time position with the condition to hire in house and the salary be paid from County Council Contingency and was 2nd by Dean McQueen. Becky Oglesby was opposed – Motion carried.

Salary Ordinance – Vice President Becky Oglesby asked to table the salary ordinance until Dec. 9 to have time to review.

2015 – Two dates that needed changed on the 2015 meeting dates.

Informed – Keith Hall asked if the employees that will be losing their position have been notified. Mr. Kramer replied they have not but would be within a few days, noting that a procedure needed to be followed to notify these employees.

Adjourn: with no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Joe Sizemore and 2nd by Daryl Kramer. Motion carried.


