The Franklin County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on March 10, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners/Council Meeting Room. Those present were Tom Wilson, Gerald Wendel, Fayette Hay, and Derrike Kolb, Chief Deputy Auditor. Absent – Tom Linkel.

OPEN: The meeting was called to order and the pledge of allegiance was led by Commissioner Wilson.

ETC LETTER OF SUPPORT – NEXT LEVEL CONNECTIONS BROADBAND GRANT: Motion to sign the Letter of Support for ETC for the Next Level Connections Broadband Grant by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Wendel, motion carried.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT – AGREEMENT FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES: The Health Department presented a contract for the Commissioners for a new Public Health Coordinator Jesus Olvera. Mr. Adams also said all he needs to get started on the work is an application from the County. Mr. Fehlinger asked the Commissioners where the process is on the application. Commissioner Wilson was not sure and was going to contact the County Engineer.

OTHER BUSINESS:


